### **U.G. Admission 2018-19**

Punjab Engineering College (PEC) (Deemed to be University), Sector 12, Chandigarh, for Admissions in all its Undergraduate Programmes, will be participating in Joint Seat Allocation Authority (JOSAA)/Central Seat Allocation Board (CSAB), 2018 along with other NITs, IIITs and Centrally Funded Technical Institutes for the Academic Session 2018-19.

**THE JOINT SEAT ALLOCATION AUTHORITY (JOSAA)** 2018 has been set up by the Ministry of Human Resources Development (MHRD) to manage and regulate the joint seat allocation for admissions to 100 institutes for the academic year 2018-19. This includes 23 IITs, 31 NITs, 23 IIITs and Other-Government Funded Technical Institutes (Other-GFTIs). Admission to all the academic programs offered by these Institutes will be made through a single platform.

**CENTRAL SEAT ALLOCATION BOARD (CSAB)** consists of NITs, SPAs, IIITs, GFTIs and other select reputed institutions or deemed universities. The CSAB-2018 is being coordinated by Malaviya National Institute of Technology (MNIT), Jaipur with its Director as the coordinating Chairman. The admission to these eminent institutions is by merit based on rank of candidates in JEE (Mains) - 2018.
