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About Punjab Engineering College

Punjab Engineering College (PEC), with its roots in Lahore as Mugalpura Engineering College since 1921, moved to its present campus in 1953 as PEC affiliated with Panjab University. The institute became a Deemed University in 2003 through an MHRD notification.

It is a Grant-in-Aid institution under the administration of the Union Territory of Chandigarh, Government of India. Admission Eligibility

CANDIDATES WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Candidates with rank in National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A). The merit list will be prepared based on the ranks obtained in National Level Entrance Examinations. In the case of a candidate appearing in "more than one" National Examination-2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A), the "best rank" in the National Level Examinations-2026 needs to be filled by the candidate.

AND

Candidates must have passed the 12th class examination (Science, Commerce, and Humanities/Arts) in the 10+2 pattern of examination of any recognized Central/State Board of Examination with atleast 60% aggregate marks. The aggregate marks for ST/SC should be at least 55%. The candidates who have appeared in the 12th class Board examination in the years 2024, 2025, and 2026 will be eligible for admission provided they fulfill all other eligibility requirements.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

For admission to the courses, each candidate must

- (a) Bear a good moral character and should not have been debarred from any institution/university,
- (b) Produce medical fitness certificate (in specified Format available as **Annexure-VI**)



PARTITIONING OF CANDIDATES

1. Each candidate is assigned a category tag according to the following criteria:
 - i. **Category tag OPEN:** This is assigned to OCI/PIO or Indian nationals of the general category who do NOT belong to the EWS, OBC-NCL, SC, or ST category (or who fail to produce an EWS, PwD, OBC-NCL, SC, or ST certificate).
 - ii. **Category tag OPEN-PwD:** This is assigned to OCI/PIO or Indian nationals who do NOT belong to the EWS, OBC, SC, or ST category (or who fail to produce a valid EWS, OBC, SC, or ST certificate) and are Persons with Disabilities. Candidates must produce a valid PwD certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-IX.**
 - iii. **Category tag EWS:** This is assigned to Indian nationals of the General category belonging to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) as defined in **Annexure-VII.**
 - iv. **Category tag EWS-PwD:** This is assigned to Indian nationals of the General category belonging to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and are Persons with Disabilities. Candidates must produce a valid EWS and PwD certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-VII** and **Annexure-IX.**
 - v. **Category tag SC:** This is assigned to Indian nationals who belong to Scheduled Castes. Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-VIII.**
 - vi. **Category tag SC-PwD:** This is assigned to Indian nationals who belong to Scheduled Castes and are Persons with Disabilities. Candidates must produce a valid SC and PwD certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-VIII** and **Annexure-IX.**
 - vii. **Category tag ST:** This is assigned to Indian nationals who belong to Scheduled Tribes. Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-VIII.**
 - viii. **Category tag ST-PwD:** This is assigned to Indian nationals who belong to Scheduled Tribes and are Persons with Disabilities. Candidates must produce a valid ST and PwD certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-VIII** and **Annexure-IX.**
 - ix. **Category tag OBC-NCL:** This is assigned to Indian nationals who belong to OBC-NCL and are NOT Persons with Disabilities. Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate (Issued on or after 1st April 2026) to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-X**



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- x. **Category tag OBC-PwD:** This is assigned to Indian nationals who belong to OBC and are Persons with Disabilities. Candidates must produce a valid OBC and PwD certificate to be assigned this tag. **Annexure-IX** and **Annexure-X**.
2. For the purpose of allocating seats, candidates are also assigned a state code of eligibility.
 - i. **Chandigarh Region**

Those candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination (12th) from schools/colleges located in the Union Territory of Chandigarh and recognized by the Chandigarh Administration, are considered under the Chandigarh Quota.
 - ii. **Outside Chandigarh Region Candidates**

All other candidates who have passed their qualifying examination (12th) from elsewhere, fall under the Other than Chandigarh Quota.
3. Specimens of the required certificates are given in **Annexures (I-X)** of this brochure.

OTHER SEATS

1. **Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmiri Valley)**

One additional seat is available for Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmiri Valley. These seats will not belong to any specific quota (Chandigarh/Other than Chandigarh) and shall be filled on the basis of the rank in National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED/ NID-DAT/ JEE (Main) Paper-2A), as mentioned in the **preference for allocation of seats**.

A candidate seeking admission against Kashmiri Migrants is required to produce a certificate from the Deputy Commissioner/ Relief Commissioner of the concerned district, to the effect that he/she belongs to a migrant family from erstwhile Jammu & Kashmir.

A candidate seeking admission against Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmiri Valley is required to produce the domicile certificate and residence proof of living in Kashmir Valley.

The admission of a candidate against this category will be provisional and subject to the verification of his/her above mentioned certificates by the issuing authority.

2. **Sportspersons**



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Benefit of reservation under this category shall be available only to the category of students, who pass their qualifying examination, as regular students, from Schools/Colleges, recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, and who have studied in Chandigarh Schools/Colleges for at least two years before applying for gradation certificate, subject to the condition that such students must have represented Chandigarh State/ Schools etc. in the National/ other recognized tournaments.

- i. Performance in the following sports disciplines only, shall be considered for the purpose of admission against this category, provided that the association/federation holding the tournaments should be affiliated to/ recognized by the National Federation of the concerned game:

- ii. To avail the benefit of reservation under this category, a candidate must obtain gradation certificate from Director of Sports, Union Territory, Chandigarh, along with other supporting sports certificates and attach the same with his/her application. No application shall be entertained in this category in the absence of



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a valid gradation certificate and all supporting documents.

NOTE: PROVISIONAL GRADATION CERTIFICATES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. NO GRADATION CERTIFICATE SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH HAS BEEN ISSUED AFTER THE LAST DATE OF ONLINE REGISTRATION.

- iii. A candidate shall be considered for admission against seats belonging to this category, only if
 - his/her age falls within the age group which is eligible for participation in Inter- College/ Inter-University tournaments.
 - Certificate will not be meant for employment purposes.
- iv. The sports gradation certificates shall be in the following descending order of merit. (Any fresh guidelines in this regard issued by Sports Department, Chandigarh Administration till the last date of online registration shall be applicable.)

Grade 'A'

Sportspersons of International standing i.e., those who have represented India in the following International Tournaments/ Meets/ Championships/ Competitions etc.

- (i) Olympic Games
- (ii) Asian Games
- (iii) Commonwealth Games
- (iv) World Cups I International Championships, organized by the international Federation of concerned sport.

Grade 'B'

Sportspersons who have participated in the following International Tournaments/ Meets/ Championships/ Competitions:

- (i) World Universities Games/World School Games/ International Tournaments/ International Games organized by International Federation of concerned Sports, other than those mentioned under Grade 'N'.
- (ii) Asian Tournaments I Championships conducted by OCA (Olympic Council of Asia)/ Asian Federation of concerned sport under the aegis of International Federation of concerned sport/SAF Games I ASEAN School Games organized by ASSC (ASEAN Schools Sports Council).
- (iii) First three positions in National Championship for Seniors Nouth/Juniors, organized by the National Sports Federation of concerned sport.
- (iv) First three positions in All India Inter-Varsity Tournaments organized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU)
- (v) Participation in International Meets/Championships for Youth/Juniors conducted by the concerned International Sports Federation of concerned sport.
- (vi) Participation in the Juniors/Seniors Nationals representing Combined Universities

- (vii) First three positions achieved by students of Chandigarh, representing Chandigarh state or KVS (Kendriya Vidyalaya Sansthan), NVS (Navodaya Vidyalaya Smiti), CBSE, IPSC (Indian Public Schools' Conference and DAV (DAV Managing committee) in the National School Games organized by the School Games Federation of India (SGFI)
- (viii) First three positions in National games/Khelo-India games organized by Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India.
- (ix) Participation in the Seniors/Youth/Juniors National Championships by the residents of Chandigarh, representing Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)/Central Government Departments as affiliated units of concerned National Sports Federation at par with State Units.

Grade 'C'

- (i) Participation in Senior Nationals/Inter Universities Tournaments, organized by the National Sports Federation of concerned sport/AIU.
- (ii) Participation in Junior National Championship I National School Games organized by National Federation of concerned sport/ SGFI.
- (iii) First three positions in the Chandigarh State Championships for Seniors, organized by Chandigarh Sport Association of concerned sport.
- (iv) First three positions in the Panjab University Inter- College Tournaments.
- (v) First three positions in the Chandigarh State Championships for Juniors organized by Chandigarh Sport Association of concerned sport.
- (vi) First three positions in Chandigarh Inter-School Tournaments conducted by Education department Chandigarh under the aegis of SGFI.
- (vii) First three positions in nationals/inter- zonal tournament of KVS/ NVS/ CBSE/DAV secured by students of Chandigarh studying in KVS, NVS, IPSC, CBSE, DAV (Affiliated units of SGFI at par with State units of SGFI).

Grade 'D'

- (i) Participation in Senior National Championships/National Games without achieving any of the first three positions in the State Championships.
- (ii) Participation in Junior National Championships without achieving any of the first three positions in the State Championships.
- (iii) Participation in National School Games without achieving any of the first three positions in the Chandigarh Inter-School Championship or nationals/ Inter- zonal of KVS /NVS I CBSE I IPSC/DAV by students of Chandigarh.
- (iv) Participation in the All-India Inter-University games without achieving any of the first three positions in the Panjab University Inter-College Championships.



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In the matter of rating inter-se, preference in the same grade shall be given in the following descending order, namely:

- a) Record holders in any event
- b) Winners
- c) Runners up
- d) 3rd position holders
- e) Number of times participated
- f) Number of disciplines participated.

NOTE:

- If there is a tie within the same category, it shall be resolved by considering the academic merit of the concerned sportspersons in National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED / NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A) as mentioned in the preference for allocation of seats.
- Regarding Senior and Junior Tournaments/ Championships, Senior shall have precedence over Junior. Further, Junior and School championships will be considered at par.
- Performance shall only be considered for the purpose of admission against this category provided that the Association/ Federation holding the tournament should be affiliated/ recognized by the National Federation of the concerned game.
 - i. Only those certificates, issued by the concerned Sports Federations/ Associations shall be entertained, as are duly signed in ink by at least one of the office bearers of the respective Sports Federations/ Associations. The position holders certificate(s) issued by the State Association must have photograph attested by the concerned association with serial number.
 - ii. The application shall be entertained only when received through an affidavit affirming the authenticity of the claim(s) duly attested by the Notary Public on non-judicial stamp paper worth ₹10/- or above. **(Annexure III)**
 - iii. In the context of Individual events/ Team Games, position achieved will be considered only if it has been achieved through a competition with seven or more competitors/ at least seven units, i.e. for State, Senior, Junior/Inter-College.
 - a) International Tournaments for Senior and Junior organized by the International Federation of that discipline and where at least 10



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countries have participated, other than those mentioned against Grade-A. Cricket will be excluded from this.

- b) At least 10 States/ Universities for Nationals, i.e. Senior/Junior and All India Inter- Varsity, respectively, shall take part for gradation purposes.
- iv. The candidate shall give an undertaking (**Annexure IV**) to the effect that he/she will attend the grounds regularly and will also participate in inter-college and inter- university tournaments when required. His/ Her admission will be cancelled if the terms of undertaking thus given, are not adhered to.
- v. ***The Director of the institute has the authority to cancel admission at any time if it is found that the candidate obtained such admission on the basis of a false certificate or incorrect statement/record.***

3. Sons/Daughters/Spouses of Military/ Paramilitary Personnel (CW)

Paramilitary personnel mean persons serving with Assam Rifles/ Border Security Force/ Central Reserve Police Force/ Central Industrial Security Force/ Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force/ Railway Protection Force/ Secretariat Force/Intelligence Bureau/National Security Guards/Special services Bureau. The ward of a Govt. official serving on deputation with paramilitary forces will not be considered for the benefit of reservation under this category. The admission of the candidates against the reserved seats under this category will be made on the basis of merit list prepared from the following categories of the applicants, in order of precedence:

- i. Whollydependent sons/daughters/spouses of military personnel/ paramilitary personnel who were killed in action while in-service.
- ii. Whollydependent sons/ daughters/ spouses of military personnel/paramilitary personnel who were disabled, to the extent of 50% or more, in action while in service and boarded out from service.
- iii. Wholly dependent sons/daughters/spouses of military/ paramilitary personnel who died while in service and whose death was attributable to military service.



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- iv. Wholly dependent sons/daughters/spouses of military personnel/paramilitary personnel who were disabled, to the extent of 50% or more, while in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military services.
- v. Wholly dependent sons/daughters/spouses of military personnel/paramilitary personnel who are awardees of Gallantry Decorations (in person or posthumously) as given below, in order of precedence:
 - ParamVir Chakra(PVC)
 - Ashok Chakra(AC)
 - MahaVir Chakra(MVC)
 - Kirti Chakra(KC)
 - Vir Chakra(VC)
 - Shaurya Chakra(SC)
 - Sena/ Nausena/ Vayusena Medal
 - Mention-in-Despatches
- v. Sons/Daughters/Spouses of ex-servicemen (military/ paramilitary personnel) who are wholly dependent on them must produce discharge Book along with Pension Book. Institute follows the guidelines for definition of ex-serviceman as described on website of Kendriya Sainik Board, Department of Ex- Servicemen Welfare - Ministry of Defence, Government of India.
- vi. Sons/Daughters/Spouses of serving military personnel/ paramilitary personnel who are wholly dependent on them. **(Annexure-V)**

Important

- The candidates claiming admission under category 3(i)/ 3(ii) are required to submit a certificate from the respective headquarters regarding death/disablement in action while in service.
- The candidates claiming admission under category 3(iii) and 3(iv) are required to submit a certificate from the respective headquarters regarding death/disablement while in service, and attributable to military service.
- The candidates claiming admission under category 3(v) are required to submit the photocopy of citation for the gallantry award along with the Gazette notification, failing which the application will not be considered in this category.



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- The candidates claiming admission under category 3(vi) are required to submit certificate of discharge from service along with photocopy the pension book of the parent/spouse and certificate of dependence on parent/spouse from the competent authority.
- The candidates claiming admission under category 3(vii) are required to submit the certificate of dependence from the unit in which parent/spouse is serving.
- In case of tie refer section preference for allocation of seats.



Preference for Allocation of Seats

Candidates with a rank in National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED/ NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A) will be considered for admission to the B. Des. program. In the case of a candidate appearing in "more than one" National Level Entrance Examination-2026 (UCEED/ NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A), the "best rank*" in the National Level Examinations-2026 needs to be filled by the candidate for admission to the B. Des. program at PEC, Chandigarh.

- I. Inter-se merit for admission in case of a tie in the rank of National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A) will be resolved in the following manner in descending order:
 - a. A candidate will be preferred based on 12th class STREAM as per the following manner in descending order:
 - i. Science
 - ii. Commerce
 - iii. Humanities/Arts
 - b. The candidate with a higher percentage of marks in 12th Class examinations will be ranked higher.
 - c. The candidate older in age will be ranked higher.

***Illustration**

Assuming Candidate 'X' scored a rank of 2446 in NID DAT and 1832 in UCEED, while Candidate 'Y' secured ranks of 3450 in UCEED, 1750 in NID DAT, and 1532 in JEE (Main) Paper-2A. Both candidates will submit their best rank obtained in National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 for admission consideration in PEC Chandigarh. The candidate 'X' filled the best rank 1832 as secured in UCEED, and Candidate 'Y' filled the best rank 1532 as secured in JEE (Main) Paper-2A. Inter-se merit for admission will be compiled based on these best ranks. Inter-se merit for admission based on the best rank in National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A), Candidate 'Y' is placed above Candidate 'X'. Tie in the inter-se merit for admission will be resolved as mentioned above.



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Note 1:

- The institute will consider the National Level Entrance Examination-2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A) results declared before the last date of registration, i.e., **26.06.2026**, and the merit list for the first four rounds will be prepared accordingly.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to fill the correct rank obtained in the National Level Entrance Examinations – 2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A)
- In the case of a candidate appearing in "more than one" National Level Entrance Examination-2026 (UCEED/NID-DAT/JEE (Main) Paper-2A), the "best rank" in the National Level Examinations-2026 needs to be filled by the candidate.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories/sub-categories. The candidates claiming reservation under OBC/ SC/ ST/ EWS/ PwD categories, Defence/Sportsperson/Kashmiri Migrants seats will be required to produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority (**as mentioned in the Annexures of this information brochure**) at the time of document verification.
- If the reserved category certificate is not found to be in order, no benefit of the reserved category will be given. Such candidates may be considered under the General category in the respective state quota.

Note 2:

- In case of any unavoidable ambiguity in the "above seat allocation procedure" during "seat allotment", the decision will be taken by the competent authority of PEC Chandigarh and shall be binding on all.



Division of Seats

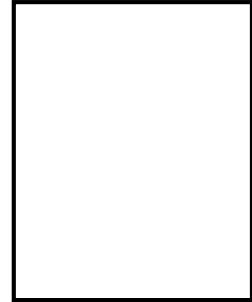
