Subject: Medical reimbursement in respect of treatment in private hospitals.

The matter regarding reimbursement of medical claims pertaining to treatment in private hospitals has been under consideration of the Department. It has been decided that wherever any Govt. employe under punjab Medical Attendance Rules, 1940 gets treatment in any private hospitals, his/her medical reimbursement bill first need to be got examined and recommended by the Director Health Services, U.T., Chandigarh. Hence, in future all cases of medical reimbursement which are sent to the Finance Department for approval should be first got verified and recommended by the D.H.S., U.T., Chandigarh by the Administrative Department in those cases where treatment has been taken from any private hospital and then only be sent to Finance Department for approval. These instructions be brought to the notice of all concerned for meticulous compliance.
