Reimbursement of Medical expenses incurred by the Punjab Govt. employees/pensioners on the treatment of Complicated Chronic Diseases as out-door patients - Policy Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention towards Govt. Letter No. 12/69/98-SHEV/21329-33 dated the 1st September, 2000, on the subject noted above vide which reimbursement of expenses incurred on out-door treatment of Complicated Chronic Diseases listed in Annexure-'A' was allowed and to say that after the issue of the above instructions employees/pensioners represented the Government for addition of some diseases to the list of Complicated Chronic Diseases. The representations have been considered and the Government has decided as under:-

- (i) To add the words "including AIDS" in brackets to the entry relating to disease mentioned at Sr. No. 10. Consequently, the entry at Sr. No. 10 of Annexure 'A' will read as:
10. Immunological disorders leading to disability (including AIDS).
- (ii) To add two diseases at Sr. No. 14 and Sr. No. 15 after Sr. No. 13 in Annexure 'A' as follows:
14. Insulin dependent diabetes mellitus and
15. Hemophilia.

2. The reimbursement of expenses, incurred on out-door treatment of the above diseases in terms of the conditions laid down in the instructions under reference will commence prospectively.


3. These instructions may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned.


