Sir,

I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Fourth Punjab Pay Commission, Governor of Punjab is pleased to enhance the existing ceilings of Implantation of Intra-Ocular Lens, Fixing of Dentures, Hearing Aid, Spectacles and increase in the limits of income of spouse (husband/wife) and other eligible dependents of Government employee, as follows: -

2. The terms and conditions already laid down, in the relevant instructions issued from time to time, for the reimbursement/admissibility of above said facilities, subject to the modifications indicated as above, will continue to be applicable.

3. The limits/rates, as enhanced above, will be applicable with effect from the date of issue of this letter.

4. These instructions may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned for information and compliance.

5. These instructions have been issued in accordance with the concurrence conveyed by the Department of Finance vide its I.D. No. 5/22/97-FPV/1064, dated 16-09-2003 and I.D. No. 5/22/97-FP1/354, dated 20-04-2004.
