Subject: Re-imbursment of Medical expenses incurred by Punjab Government employees/
pensioners on the treatment of Complicated Chronic Diseases as outdoor patient-Policy
regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and to say that the question of identifying ailments as Complicated Chronic Diseases and allowing re-imbursment of expenses incurred by Punjab Government employees/pensioners on the outdoor treatment of such diseases in respect of themselves or members of their family as defined for the purposes of the Punjab Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1940, was under consideration of the State Government for some time. After careful consideration, the Government have decided to issue a list of Complicated Chronic Diseases enclosed as Annexure-A to this letter in which the re-imbursment of expenses incurred on out-door treatment, including pre-indoor and post-indoor treatment, shall be allowed to the extent indicated below and subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) No re-imbursment will be allowed if the expenditure on out door treatment in the case of an employee/pensioner or any dependent member(s) of his family suffering from any Complicated Chronic Disease enumerated in Annexure-A does not exceed Rs. 6,000 (Rupees Six thousand) per annum.
- (ii) For expenses incurred in excess of amount mentioned in (i) above full re-imbursment will be allowed to employees/pensioners:
Provided the amount of re-imbursment will be correspondingly reduced, if any aid is claimed/received from any other source including Medical Insurance/Accident Insurance etc.
- (iii) The first certificate that the employee/pensioner or any dependent member(s) of his family is suffering from any of the Complicated Chronic Disease, will be obtained from any State Government Medical College, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGI) Chandigarh and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi. The patient will have to present him self/herself for fresh check-up after one year or a shorter period as the Medical Authority mentioned above may require.
- (iv) The re-imbursment shall be subject to the verification of the rates and justification of the expenditure incurred as per existing rules.

(v) Fixed Medical Allowance will continue to be payable as a separate element.

(vi) A standing committee consisting of the following is hereby constituted to consider further additions/deletions from the list of Complicated Chronic Diseases (Annexure-A) :—

2. Complicated Chronic Disease Certificate will be issued by the authorised College/Institute in the Format as per Annexure-B.


3. An attested photo copy of Complicated Chronic Diseases Certificate shall invariably be attached with each medical claim.

These instructions will also apply to all retired members of All India Services (borne on the Punjab cadre), their wives/husbands and retired Judges of Punjab and Haryana High Court, their wives/husbands, who after retirement have settled in Punjab and draw their pension through Punjab Government Treasuries.

5. These instructions may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned.

6. These instructions, issue with the concurrence of the Department of Finance conveyed,—vide their I.D. No. 5/22/97-FPI/933, dated 22nd August, 2000.


