At the outset the Director gave his analysis on the Observations and Governance Issues highlighted by the External Peer Review Committee (EPRC), through their Report presented to the BoG in its 72nd Meeting in February 2023.

The Board asked the Institute to undertake following actions, before the Proposed ActionPlan is presented to the BoG:-

- (a) The Action Taken Points may be converted into Quantifiable Outcomes with well-defined Timelines for their Implementation, their Impact on the Institute including NIRF ranking.
- (b) The content of the Report be shared with all the stakeholders in the Institute, as well as other Agencies/ Authorities to obtain their views on the proposed Action Taken Plan/Way Forward and clear cut Responsibilities be assigned for implementation of the measures as worked out after detailed deliberations.
- (c) A common strategy be adopted by PEC, PU and NITTTR for conducting UG Programmes by these Institutions for greater benefit of the target population.
- (d) Research schedule should be drawn annually, in which all faculty participate compulsorily, so as to give greater impetus to the research in the Institute, which is lacking as on date, thus having adversarial impact on NIRF ranking of the Institute.
- (e) Greater emphasis be given on developing ERP for the Institute at the Institute level.

Keeping in mind the above, a Road Map may be drawn and presented to the BoG in future, specifying Tangible Outcomes. The same to be placed in ensuing BoG Meeting as one of the Agenda Item, as and when the same is finalized after detailed deliberations with all stakeholders.
