Rules & Regulations of Swimming Pool

- 1. The swimming pool is for the use of students, faculty members and staff of PEC.
- 2. Wives and children of the faculty members and staff are allowed the use of the swimming pool as "dependent members" provided however, that children under the age of 6 years shall not be allowed and that children between the age of 6 to 15 years are accompanied by either of the parents or their nominee.
- 3. Student may submit photocopy of Identity Card and Medical Examination Certificate duly signed by the Medical Officer, PEC, Chandigarh.
- 4. The faculty members and staff members may submit their applications for swimming pool membership of their family members duly signed by respective Head alongwith one recent photo, Medical Examination Certificate duly signed by the M.O., PEC, Chandigarh and a fee receipt of Rs.250/- per head for current swimming season only i.e. upto 31st October.
- 5. Only such persons as are declared medically fit by the Medical Officer, shall be enrolled as member of Swimming Pool.
- 6. Always keep in mind that your life is more important than anything else on this World.
- 7. Do not run around the pool or indulge in horse play/jumping or push people into the water who are nervous or non-swimmers.
- 8. Cut your nails at regular intervals. Do not put on bangles, Kadas, Holy thread, chain, rings or similar things while swimming.
- 9. Do not swim alone and beyond your capacity. Never be over confident about your swimming ability.
- 10. Children swimming with inflated teaching aid need strict supervision.
- 11. Do not imitate drowning. Don't go for rescuing and drowning person if you are not capable or confident of it.
- 12. Do not swim when hungry, exhaustive, overheated and for atleast an hour after a meal.
- 13. Follow the instructions of the staff on duty at all times for your safety.
- 14. Permission to swim in the Swimming Pool is at the swimmer's own risk and responsibility. The swimmers will have to observe the rules and regulations of the Swimming Pool.
- 15. Members are required to deposit their identity cards with the Swimming Pool Attendant before entering in the Swimming Pool, which may be collected while leaving the Swimming Pool Complex. Any Identity card left with the Attendant after the closure of the Swimming Pool will be cancelled without any notice.
- 16. All Swimming Pool users are required to take a shower bath with soap and clean nose & mouth before entering in the Swimming Pool. When in pool make use of scum gutters.
- 17. All users must enter the cess pool to clean their feet before entering the Swimming Pool.
- 18. All the Swimming Pool users with long (head) hairs are required to wear the waterproof caps while in the Swimming Pool.
- 19. Proper Swimming Costumes should be used while swimming.
- 20. Beginners or learners should wear red caps for identification.
- 21. Persons suffering from any skin or infectious or contagious diseases are not allowed to enter in the Swimming Pool.
- 22. Refreshments should not be served or taken on or in the Swimming Pool.
- 23. The Swimming Pool staff accepts no responsibility for the safety of property of users, their dependents clothing's etc. may be left in the dressing rooms or in the lockers entirely at owner's risk. Users are advised not to leave money or valuables in the dressing rooms or lockers.
- 24. Full value will be charges for any damage, breakage or loss of the Swimming Pool Complex property by the users or their dependents.
- 25. Gentlemanly behaviour is expected from all Swimming Pool users and in the Swimming Pool to ensure the safety of all Swimming Pool users. Mischievous behaviour may entail cancellation of membership/entry in the Swimming Pool.
- 26. No Swimming Pool user shall interfere with the duties of any members of the Swimming Pool staff.
- 27. Pets are not allowed within the premises of the swimming pool.
- 28. Accompanying persons/parents must sit on the spectator gallery and keep strict watch on their wards.
- 29. Smoking in and around the Swimming Pool Complex is strictly prohibited.
- 30. Co-operation of the members is necessary for the enforcement of these rules.
