

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION FOR PH.D. ENTRANCE TEST

1. Candidates having valid GATE/ NET-JRF Score are exempted from the entrance test.
2. Scholarship positions are available for only candidates having valid GATE/NET-JRF score as well as for those candidates who did M.E./ M.Tech. with GATE and was getting Institute assistantship. **Candidates who did M.E./ M.Tech. with GATE and was getting GATE Scholarship are required to qualify the entrance test.**
3. The candidates who did M.E./ M.Tech. with GATE and was getting Institute assistantship are required to provide the proof of the same at the time of document verification/ interview.
4. For all other the candidates an entrance test will be conducted for admission in the session 2024-25 (July 2024 Session).
5. Entrance test will be a multiple choice test; each question will have four options with only one correct answer.
6. The entrance test will carry 90 marks and it will have two parts, Part A of 30 marks and Part B of 60 marks. Qualifying marks in the entrance test will be overall 50%.
 - a) Part A will have 30 questions of 1 mark each on Research Methodology. It will be common to all the students and its duration will be 30 minutes.
 - b) Part B will be stream/ discipline specific and it will have 60 questions of 1 mark each. Its duration will be 60 minutes.
7. Candidates who have secured 50% marks in the entrance test are eligible to be called for interview.
8. A relaxation of 5% marks will be allowed in the entrance examination for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/differently-abled category.
9. The selection of non-GATE/non-NET-JRF candidates will be based on the entrance test and interview.
10. The weightage of 70% for the entrance test and 30% for the performance in the interview/viva- voce shall be given.
11. Candidates who will qualify entrance test are required to visit the department/centre on **10.06.2024-11.06.2024** to meet all perspective supervisors to give the preference for research supervisors. Candidate has to submit filled **Annexure-III** (as per PhD Admission Brochure) in the department before interview.
12. The selection of the GATE/ NET-JRF candidates will be on the basis of their performance in the interview/ viva-voce.

13. Candidate has to bring the photo identity card proof along with copy of Registration form and fee receipt.
14. Use good quality ball point pen **(blue)** strictly
15. Candidate must not use headphones, ear buds, or any other type of electronic gadgets. Candidate must not use a phone for any reason.
