The experts from MDI Gurgaon, NIT Jalandhar and UBS, Chandigarh visited the campus on 04 December 2023 as Selection Committee Members and they strongly recommended that the Centre should start MBA in the niche areas such as Business Analytics, Data Analytics and Decision Making, and Data Sciences. They emphasized on the noticeable inclination and preference of students towards MBA with an observed decline in M.Tech. admissions. Further. admissions in the current landscape aligns with the current industrial need catering to a wider range of students of all fostering diversity and streams. adaptability.

In this regard, the CMH was asked to prepare a proposal for MBA programme. The proposal was sent to IAPC for discussion. After detailed deliberation in the IAPC meeting held on 06 February 2024 the proposal was recommended to Senate.

- The Name of the Program shall be Master of Business Administration MBA (Business & Data Analytics)
- 2. The program will be started with 30 Seats
- The eligibility Criteria will be as follows: -
- i. 12th class or higher level with Mathematics. Score in Mathematics subject should be ≥ 60%
- ii. Candidate must havepossessed Bachelor's Degree (Approved by UGC/AICTE) of minimum 3 years with at least 60% marks (relaxation to the reserved category as per norms).
