I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to inform you that the Budget Estimates for the next financial year 2024-25 in respect of your department/office has been finalized by the Finance Department, Chandigarh Administration as per the attached statement.

All efforts should be made to keep a close watch on the pace of expenditure from the commencement of financial year. The guidelines as well as responsibilities of Drawing and Disbursing Officer, Controlling Officers and Heads of Departments for the control of expenditure against the sanctioned grant have been detailed in Rule 57 to 70 of General Financial Rules, 2017.

For the next Financial Year 2024-25, the interim budget has been presented and the Govt. of India has allocated 41.66% budget to the Chandigarh Administration of the total allocation to be utilized from April to August, 2024 (excluding expenditure on new services items). Since, the Parliament has passed Vote on Account for the F.Y. 2024-25, therefore, while utilizing the funds provided to the Department it maybe ensured that no expenditure should be utilized beyond the prescribed limit as under:

Superintendent (Billing)-cum-ACPIO Punjab Engineering College, Further, the department may prioritize to utilize the expenditure on the Object Heads such as Salary, Wages, Grant-in-Aid (Salary) and arrear of DA, thereafter the rest of the amount may be spent to other object heads, but within the prescribed limit. In no case, any sort of arrear except DA arrear is permissible to be withdrawn till the Final Budget is presented and passed by the Parliament. Any violation of the above guidelines shall be viewed seriously and concerned DDO and Head of the Department will be held responsible.

The expenditure in the last quarter of the financial year should be strictly restricted to the 33% of the annual budget provision and for the month of March, 2025 shall not exceed 15% of the total budget provision. This aspect of reviewing monthly expenditure must be strictly adhered to, without any exception as Ministry of Finance is already monitoring this aspect especially for considering any additional demands of funds through the Revised Estimates.
