IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION FOR PH.D. ENTRANCE TEST

- 1. Candidates having GATE/ NET Score are exempted from the entrance test.
- 2. The candidates who did M.E./ M.Tech. with GATE and was getting Institute assistantship are required to provide the proof of the same at the time of document verification/interview.
- 3. For all other the candidates an entrance test will be conducted for admission in the session 2025-26 (January 2026 Session).
- 4. Entrance test will be a multiple choice test; each question will have four options with only one correct answer.
- 5. The entrance test will carry 90 marks and it will have two parts, Part A of 30 marks and Part B of 60 marks. Qualifying marks in the entrance test will be overall 50%.
- a) Part A will have 30 questions of 1 mark each on Research Methodology. It will be common to all the students and its duration will be 30 minutes.
- b) Part B will be stream/ discipline specific and it will have 60 questions of 1 mark each. Its duration will be 60 minutes.
- 6. Candidates who have secured 50% marks in the entrance test are eligible to be called for interview.
- 7. A relaxation of 5% marks will be allowed in the entrance examination for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/differently-abled category.
- 8. The selection of non-GATE/non-NET candidates will be based on the entrance test and interview.
- 9. The weightage of 70% for the entrance test and 30% for the performance in the interview/viva-voce shall be given.
- 10. Candidates who will qualify entrance test are required to visit the department/centre on 08.12.2025 to meet all perspective supervisors to give the preference for research supervisors. Candidate has to submit filled Annexure-III in the department before interview.
- 11. The selection of the GATE/ NET candidates will be on the basis of their performance in the interview/ viva-voce.
- 12. Candidate has to bring the photo identity card proof along with copy of Registration form and fee receipt.
- 13. Use good quality ball point pen (blue) strictly

- 14. Candidate must not use headphones, ear buds, or any other type of electronic gadgets.

 Candidate must not use a phone for any reason.
- 15. Candidate are allowed to use non-programmable scientific calculator only.
