This is to certify that Punjab Engineering College, Deemed to be University (formerly PEC University of Technology) does not award absolute marks but follows a grading system. The performance of a student in a particular semester is measured by the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) while the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) indicates the overall academic performance of a student upto the last completed semester. Both of these are calculated on a 10-point scale.

For all the students admitted prior to the session 2010-11, the indicative percentage of marks equivalent to a Grade Point Average may, however, be obtained by the following formula:

$$\text{Approximate Equivalent Percentage of Marks} = (\text{CGPA} - 0.5) \times 10$$

For all the students admitted to the session 2010-11 and onwards, our institute doesn't specify any conversion formula. However, a CGPA of 6.0 is considered as equivalent to 60% for placement purposes only.
