Minutes of Meeting held for framing a policy regarding the GATE fee reimbursement and providing other incentives/ awards to the final year B.Tech. Students.

A meeting was held on 21.08.2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the office of Head Computer Centre. Coordinator TEQIP-III, briefed about an email dated 03.04.2019 received from NPIU emphasizing need to focus on enhanced participation of students in GATE examination.

In this regard, a policy for PEC duly approved by competent authority is as follows:

1. CDGC will conduct GATE training common to all branches from the agencies empaneled by NPIU as per past practice.
2. In addition, teaching departments will also conduct GATE training classes on important topics in core areas. The departments will be permitted for an engagement of faculty from within the department or from reputed institute outside PEC, against a remuneration per lecture @ Rs. 1,500/- and @3000/- respectively. Although, the departments can decide on the number of such classes, however, the payment of remuneration in a year will be limited to 80 for a department and 20 lectures per faculty.
3. Reimbursement of GATE registration fee is recommended for those students, who qualify GATE examination.
4. The cash prizes are recommended for students who perform well at the national or institute level. A branch-wise cash prize scheme is also recommended for those students, who perform well and obtain GATE score above a certain threshold. A branch-wise threshold GATE score will be determined from average GATE score of previous three years, Annexure-I gives valid threshold GATE score for GATE'2020. The cash prizes details are given below.
