76.1	<p>To Consider the PG curriculum</p> <p>To consider the IAPC approved structure and curriculum of M.Tech 1st Semester courses</p>	<p>After detailed deliberations the content and syllabi of all the 1st semester courses of various M.Tech. Programmes as recommended by IAPC, were approved as the new PG structure and scheme to be implemented from the new academic session 2018-19. Following was also recommended:-</p> <p>i) In each course, corresponding MOOCs courses will be listed.</p> <p>ii) For those courses where the MOOCs courses are being run in a blended mode, there will be one hour loading of either tutorial or practical per week. The corresponding teacher will be given that loading and shall compulsorily register for that MOOCs course. The fee of registration may be booked to his/ her PDA/ PDF.</p> <p>iii) The content and syllabi for courses to be seen for second semester will be discussed in the next Senate meeting.</p>
