It was desired that performance of the students should be monitored throughout the year and necessary steps should be taken to improve the academic performance of students.</p> <p>c. The Senate desired that ME course structure needs to be reviewed. A Committee comprising Dr. Rajesh Bhatia (Chairman), Dr. N.M. Suri, Dr. Tarlochan Kaur, Dr. Tripta Goyal, Dr. R.K. Sehmi and Dr. Sushant Samir (Convenor) was constituted for the purpose.</p>
65.3	To approve the revision of syllabi of Mechatronics System Design course of M.E. Industrial Design.	It was decided that the course contents be sent to NITIE, Mumbai to examine inclusion of contents related to System Design.
